Some of you may be here for the first time though, and perhaps surprised and a bit disappointed to see the bulls presented so naturally & rough and a bit dirty. **Do not be disappointed.** The bulls here have genetics you can rely on for profit. They have been reared to exhibit hardiness, thriftiness and fitness and still perform well. They will work and continue to grow and will not require special treatment and feeding. They will produce crops of calves that make you proud.

Then you will be delighted!

This is our 10th crop from our imported **Line One** Hereford genetics, and they are true "red-meat" bulls. Consistency is getting stronger.

Outwintered on the shore fields until December and then in our open corals, they are more than ready to go on and thrive wherever you put them.

## Catalogue Information.

We strive to provide meaningful performance data in the catalogue. No creep is fed to calves before weaning in order to measure true maternal performance from grass. The youngstock are reared in their full group to also allow for true natural performance recording.

We ultrasound the entire bull and heifer crop each summer for muscle depth and back fat and provide meaning full EBV's on all the bulls as well as actual birth weights.

All the bulls are fertility checked by our vet prior to sale day to ensure that we sell only bulls that are fit for purpose. Scrotal measurements taken by the vet are also in the catalogue.

I urge you to study the merit of each bull, use your eye and the data provided to help you choose the bull with the best genetics and type to suit your herd. Please ask me for any extra information on their background not already provided. Regarding our calving ease figures, as a herd, we have no extreme birth weights and unassisted births have been a priority since starting the herd in 1969.

## Extended payment terms.

We must thank our auctioneer, Harry Begg from C & D Auctions Ltd., for again offering you extended payment terms on the bulls today through to April. If this suits you then sort it out with Harry and leave the bulls here till April at your own risk. **Insurance is advised.**
